

CATÁN

This triangular, unstemmed point has straight to slightly convex lateral edges that are sometimes beveled and a convex, well-rounded base that has been thinned by the removal of one or two broad, arc-shaped flakes. The outline is similar to *Abasolo*, but *Catán* points are smaller.



Distribution: Typical of south Texas and into northeast México./**Period:** Late Archaic to Late Prehistoric./**Sites:** La Perdida; 41DV1, 41DV2, 41DV3; Sierra de Tamaulipas, México; Cueva de la Zona de Derrumbes Rockshelter, México
