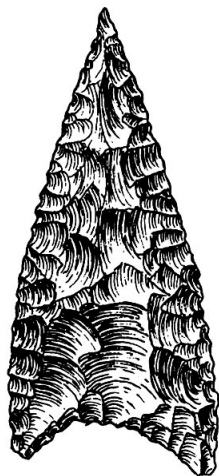
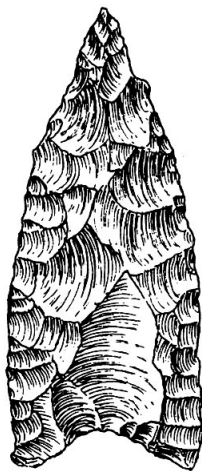
## KINNEY

This unstemmed, triangular to elongate-triangular point has a slightly to deeply concave base.

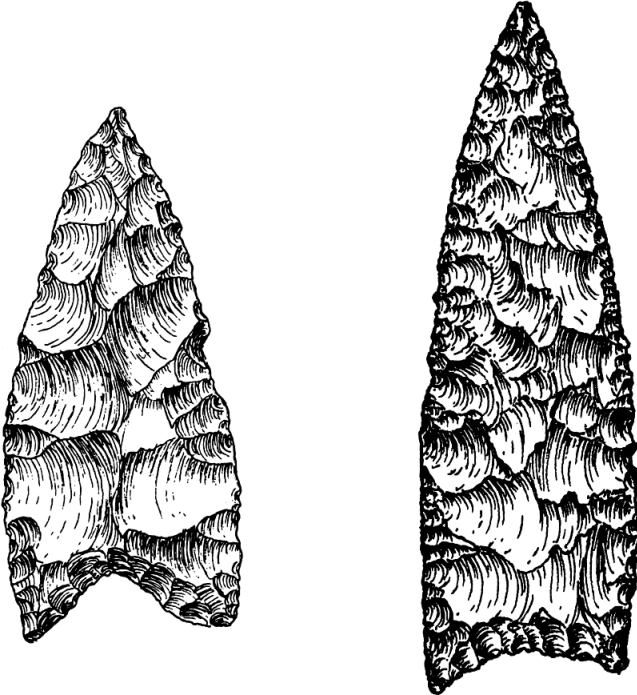
Weir and Doran (1980) named a similar form found at the Anthon site "Anthon," but a subsequent analysis by Glen Goode suggested that "Anthon" is really a knife in the last stage of thinning (F. Weir, personal communication).



**Distribution:** Central and south Texas and the lower Pecos. **Period:** Middle Archaic. **Sites:** La Jita; Morhiss; Damp Cave; Anthon
